

TIMELINE

1969: Stonewall Riots

In June 1969, the Stonewall Inn, a gay bar in New York City, became the site of a series of demonstrations and clashes between LGBTQ+community members and the police. These events, known as the Stonewall Riots or Stonewall Uprising, are widely considered a pivotal moment in the LGBTQ+ rights movement, sparking increased activism and calls for equality.

1970: First Pride March

On June 28, 1970, the first Pride March, then called the Christopher Street Liberation Day March, took place in New York City to commemorate the anniversary of the Stonewall Riots. The march attracted thousands of participants and marked a significant step in the visibility and recognition of the LCBTQ+ community.

1978: Rainbow Flag

Gilbert Baker, an artist and LGBTQ+ rights activist, designed the iconic rainbow flag as a symbol of LGBTQ+ pride. The flag, originally consisting of eight colors, later revised to six colors, represented diversity and inclusivity within the community. The rainbow flag quickly gained popularity and became widely recognized as a symbol of LGBTQ+ pride.

1969

1994: Stonewall Inn Declared a National Historic Landmark

In 1994, the Stonewall Inn was designated as a National Historic Landmark by the U.S. Department of the Interior. This recognition affirmed the historical significance of the Stonewall Riots and the ongoing struggle for LGBTQ+ rights.

2000: Presidential

In June 2000, U.S. President Bill Clinton declared June as Gay and Lesbian Pride Month, marking the first time a sitting U.S. President officially recognized and acknowledged Pride Month.

TIMELINE

2011: "Don't Ask, Don't Tell" Repealed

On September 20, 2011, the U.S. military's "Don't Ask, Don't Tell" policy, which prohibited openly gay and lesbian individuals from serving, was officially repealed. This marked a significant victory for LGBTQ+ rights and equality within the armed forces.

2015: Same-Sex Marriage Legalized in the United States

On June 26, 2015, the U.S. Supreme Court ruled in the case of Obergefell v. Hodges that same-sex marriage is a constitutional right, making it legal nationwide. This landmark decision was a major milestone for LGBTQ+ rights in the United States.

2020: Worldwide Protests and Black Lives Matter Movement

In the wake of the murder of George Floyd and the resurgence of the Black Lives Matter movement, Pride Month 2020 saw an increased focus on intersectionality and the fight against racial injustice. Many Pride events and celebrations incorporated activism and solidarity with the Black community.

2011

2021: 50th Anniversary of Pride Month

The year 2021 marked the 50th anniversary of Pride Month since the first Pride March in 1970. Despite the COVID-19 pandemic, various virtual events, parades, and celebrations took place worldwide to commemorate the milestone and continue advocating for LGBTQ+ rights.

2023: Ongoing Celebration and Activism

Pride Month continues to be celebrated annually in June, with LGBTQ+ communities and allies around the world organizing events, parades, festivals, and educational activities to promote visibility, equality, and acceptance. The month serves as a reminder of the progress made in LGBTQ+ rights and the ongoing work needed to achieve full equality for all.


